<u>CLIENT ALERT – CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19)</u> Commissioner Extends Hero Act Designation

Dear Clients and Friends:

The Commissioner of Health has extended the Hero Act Designation for COVID-19 through October 31, 2021. This means employers must continue to require follow their policies, provide training to employees (if they have not already done so), and avoid retaliation against employees for reporting concerns. COVID-19 Related Leave for Employees

Employers are reminded that New York's COVID guarantine leave remains in effect. New York has also issued guidance for employers regarding employees who must take leave from work due the quarantine of a minor child to here. https://paidfamilyleave.ny.gov/if-your-minor-dependent-child-guarantined. Parents in this situation may be eligible for Paid Family Leave.


